
#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Examination fee to be paid separately by the students as per university norms.
- Clinical Fee as per clinical requirement.
- Transportation charge to be paid by the students separately.
- The students are expected to buy the prescribed uniforms and books and other stationaries at their own cost
- Hostel & Mess fee Rs. ..... per month to be paid before 10th of every month.
- GNM Annual fees of 2nd & 3rd year should be paid by 31st of January and ANM, B.Sc., Post Basic B.Sc. should be paid by 31st of July every year failing to pay a fine of Rs. 2000/- per month will be taken.
- It is compulsory that every selected students should stay in the hostel.
- Discontinue Course: There will be "No refund" of fees paid for the admission. They have to pay whole course fee if they withdrawn admission.

# Rules & Regulation

- 1) Every student is required to attend at least 90% of the classes.
- 2) Every student is supposed to be punctual and disciplined in the premises.
- 3) The student must submit the assignment on or before the date fixed by the teacher.
- 4) No student will go on leave without prior permission from the principal. Available leave :- Annual Leave 30 days, Sick Leave 10 days per year.
- 5) Late comers will not be allowed to attend the class without permission from the principal.
- 6) It is compulsory that every selected student stay in the hostel, staying outside the hostel will be not allowed.
- 7) Visiting day only on Sunday. Parents/Gaurdians whose photo submitted in the visiting register. Jija, Uncle & Cousin brothers are not allowed.
- 8) Students shall wear prescribed uniform while on duty or college premises.
