The state has a tropical climate the period between October & February is the most appropriate time for visiting the state.

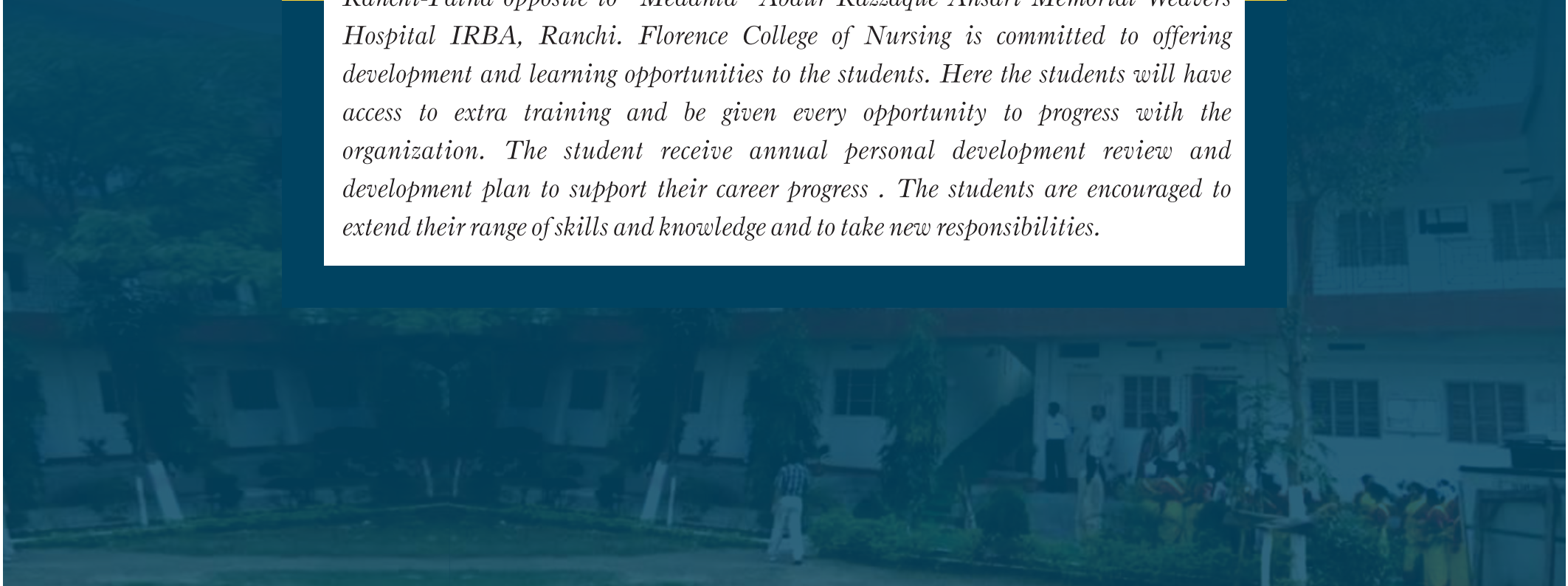
About the College

- Eligibility : 10+2 pass any stream
- Age for the entrance should be 17 years to 35 years.
- Female candidate are eligible .

General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM)

Course Duration 3 years

- Eligibility : 10+2 pass with aggregate of 40%, required English (ST, SC 5% relaxation)
- Age for the entrance should be 17 years to 35 years.
- Male & Female candidate are eligible.
- Candidate should be medically fit.
- Following examination rules of Jharkhand Nurses council.

Basic B.Sc. Nursing

Course Duration 4 years

- Eligibility : 10+2 pass with Science (Physics, Chemistry Biology & English) subject with aggregate of 45% (ST, SC 5% relaxation)
- Age for the entrance should be 17 years.
- Male & Female candidate are eligible.
- Candidate should be medically fit.
- Following examination rules of Ranchi University.

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing

Course Duration 2 years

- Eligibility : GNM Pass.
- Male & Female candidate are eligible.
- Candidate should be medically fit.
- Following examination rules of Ranchi University.

M.Sc. Nursing

Course Duration 2 years

- Eligibility : B.Sc./Post Basic B.Sc. pass.
- Minimum 1 year experience. (Clinical / Teaching)
- Male & Female candidate are eligible.
- Candidate should be medically fit.
- Following examination rules of Ranchi University.

Application how to apply

Criteria for Selection :

- There will be written test in science subjects, G.K. & English.
- Interview for successful candidate.
- The selected candidates must be prepared to obtain admission, immediately.
- The candidate should bring all the original certificates during their interview and after confirmation of admission, candidate must submit their original certificates during their training period.

Important Notes

- Examination fee to be paid separately by the students as per University & Council norms.
- Clinical & Transportation charges to be paid by the students separately.
- The students are expected to buy the prescribed uniforms and books and other stationeries at their own cost.
- Hostel & Mess fee per month to be paid before 10th of every month.
- GNM annual fees of B.Sc., Post Basic B.Sc. & M.Sc. should be paid by 31st of September every year. If candidates are fail to pay as mention month then fine will be applicable.
- It is compulsory for every selected undergraduate students should stay in the hostel.
- Discontinue course : There will be "No refund" of fees paid for the admission. They have to pay whole course fee if they withdrawn admission.



Class Room & Laboratory Facilities

The class rooms are equipped with modern teaching aids such as over head projector, LCD Projector, Magnetic Boards, Power Presentation Techniques etc. The college of nursing have various laboratory with mannequins anatomic models and equipments similar to hospital units.

The purpose of the teaching – learning process in the Nursing Laboratory is to allow students to use the knowledge they have acquired and assimilate other skills that are necessary to perform the techniques correctly. The usual routine is to perform a demonstration of the procedure with the purpose of showing the specific material and the order of steps to be followed.

Clinical Experience

Nursing Training is a combination of theoretical and practical learning experiences that enable nursing students to acquire the knowledge, Skills and attitudes for providing nursing care. Training of the students is composed of two complementary parts : Theoretical training and practical training, A large part of nursing education is carried out in clinical environment.

It is compulsory to every students, They have to complete their clinical posting as per the Indian Nursing Council, we are providing various hospital exposure to our students to learn the nursing procedures and they are evaluated on more than twenty clinical procedures during their practicum according to their level in nursing programme.



Computer Lab

Computer Laboratory classes have played a major role in education, In our college students are getting computer class facilities.

Hostel Facilities

There is an exclusive hostel within the campus for the nursing students. Students are accommodate in spacious well ventilated rooms. Hygienic food items are provided in the mess. The college runs hostels for the male and female students separately within the campus .

Students can take admission form from the office on the month of February onwards. Followed by Entrance test, on the merit basis students can take admission.

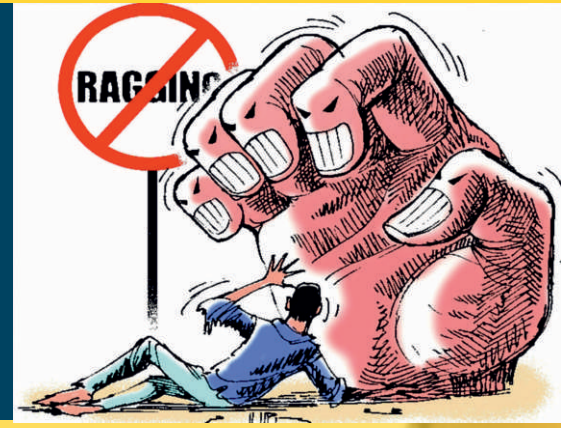
If any candidate wants to withdraw his/her admission from the college then, a written information should be send to the office a month in advance and pay full course academic fee.
